Citizens State Bank has been there to help them through five separate additions to the Cologne property, the opening of a second showroom in Rochester, and the acquisition and buildout of the former Econofoods building in Norwood Young America.

The technological advances used in their shops are simply amazing. What used to be done by hand on a table saw is now completed by running programs on a computer. ### Watch Out For This Scam!

A new scam has been occurring across the country. Even though we haven't been notified by any of our customers falling into this trap, we feel you should be made aware of it. The scammer starts by sending you a fake email that appears to come from your bank. The email says there is an issue with your account and the bank team needs to investigate. Of course, there isn't actually an issue, but the scammer posing as the bank offers to help you fix it. They have you download legitimate remote desktop software that is normally used by IT professionals to assist you.

In this case, the software you downloaded does not contain a virus or malware, so it won't be picked up by your antivirus software. When you allow them to access your desktop, they have full control of your computer. They can use this to gain access to your financial accounts and data.

Follow these tips to avoid falling victim to a remote desktop scam:

• Be suspicious of any unexpected emails claiming there is an issue with your account. If you have reason to believe the request is genuine, call us at 952-467-3000 or email us at wecanhelp@csbnya.com.

• Never give control of your computer to someone who contacts you, even if they claim to be from your bank or tech support.

Never share passwords or login information with anyone. This data is personal, and your bank will never ask you for it.
