Citizens was again the local expert on the Paycheck Protection Program. We chose to

Our team evaluated each customer's specific situation, and on top of that, we provided one-on-one guidance completing the application forms. Citizens State Bank provided \$10,300,388.45 in local economic stimulus to hard-working business people and farmers through PPP loans. Our team will be communicating with our customers to initiate the forgiveness process for the PPP loans in the coming months. We are very thankful for the opportunity to serve both existing and new customers, especially when the financial impact for the businesses, farmers and their employees is so great.

This is another clear example that Citizens State Bank continues to stand apart from its competitors.

Citizens State Bank worked hard to personally help businesses through the process of applying for a PPP loan. The bank made a difference in our community and provided critical funding to our local businesses in 2020-2021.

In round two of the PPP, Citizens helped 412 businesses with 1053 employees receive \$10.3 million in PPP loans over the course of 121 days!

In both rounds of the PPP, Citizens provided 624 forgivable loans totaling over \$21 million. That made a difference during the pandemic. The PPP crew included Kami, Lynne, Martha, Perry, Bruce, David and Jason.


